

PMS stands for Pantone Matching System. PMS colours are standardized colours listed in the Pantone Colour Matching System. Each Pantone colour has a specific code which printers and manufacturers can refer to in order to ensure colour consistency.

- For a 1 PMS colour envelope, artwork must be supplied containing only one PMS colour
  - For a 2 PMS colour envelope, artwork must be supplied containing exactly two PMS colours
- All colours must be selected from the Pantone Solid Uncoated palette. A list of Pantone Solid Uncoated colours can be found below.

Please note, all image file formats (except Adobe Photoshop) and all Microsoft Word documents do not support PMS colours. If you are supplying artwork for a PMS colour job, DO NOT supply these formats. Our preferred file type is always press ready PDF's.
